Zwentendorf NPP – is the first commercial nuclear plant for electric power generation built in Austria. Construction of the plant at Zwentendorf, Austria was completed, but the plant never entered service due to a referendum in 1978.

Today, it serves as a research center, security training center, and a tourist attraction. Visitors can explore the plant's history, its role in the nuclear energy debate, and its current uses.
